i) Citations

Publications based on ESS data should acknowledge this by:

a) a bibliographic citation: R Jowell and the Central Co-ordinating team, European Social Survey 2004/2005: Technical Report, London: Centre for Comparative Social Surveys, City University (2006)

b) a reference to NSD as the data archive and distributor of ESS data.

To ensure that such attributions are captured for social science bibliographic utilities, citations must appear in the footnotes or in the reference section of publications.

ii) Confidentiality

In accordance with data protection regulations in participating countries, only anonymous data are available to users. Before depositing data to the ESS Data Archive at Norwegian Social Science Data Services (NSD), each national team has been responsible for checking their data with confidentiality in mind. Anonymity is also maintained after merging of data files.

iii) Access

The data are available without restrictions for not-for-profit purposes.
